

## Saddle Stitching

### Ionising Sword

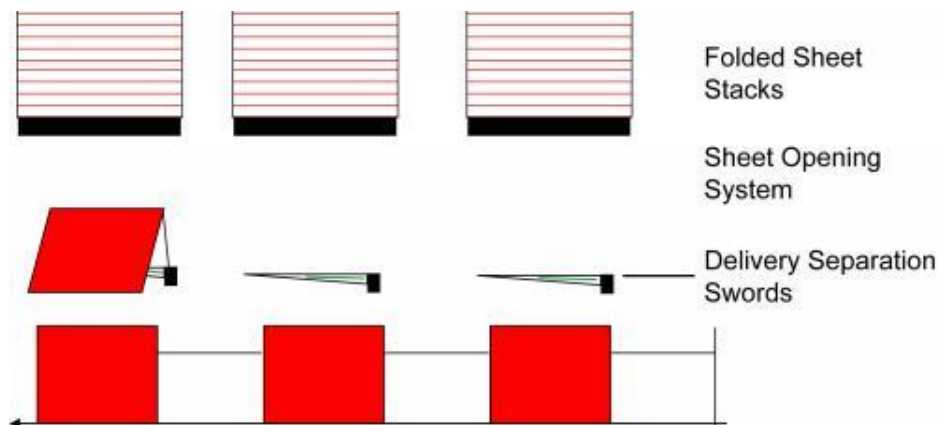
#### Problem

The static charges generated when a page is opened to drop cleanly onto a saddle stitch conveyor often leads to the re-closure of such pages and the inability of the page to collate on the conveyor. High speed systems can grind to a halt.

#### Solution

Small ionising delivery separation swords installed as shown will propel ionisation into the opening sheet. Static charges are neutralised and re-closure is prevented.
